### **DIRECTIONS:**

#### **From the north:**

From RT 695, take RT 83 south to the North Avenue exit. Take the exit **straight** through the light onto Mount Royal Avenue. Stay to the right side over the light rail tracks and take the **right hand split** by the Mount Royal RR station onto Cathedral Street. Turn **right** onto Martin Luther King. Follow MLK until you pass Baltimore Street. A new lane will appear on the right, move into that lane and turn **right** onto West Lombard Street.

(Continue directions below \*\*\*)

#### **From the south:**

Take RT 95 to RT 395 to Martin Luther King Highway. Just past the stadiums, turn **left** onto West Lombard Street. (Continue Directions below\*\*\*)

### **\*\*\*(Continue directions)**

Turn **left** onto Arlington. Proceed **straight** through the light at Pratt Street, between the buildings, over the cobblestone/brick circle (watch out for pedestrians) and enter the parking lot on the left. Tell the guard you are attending the conference. Make sure your car is between the lines when you park or it will be towed. (We need every space)

Facing the BBH buildings from the parking lot, the Conference Center is on the second floor of the building on the right. Should there be no room remaining in the parking lot, simply continue on the road next to the BBH parking lot to the stop sign. Turn right and park in the shopping center lot close to the Pratt Street end.
